



AGM Elections and Motions — Opening Notice

Boxing Ireland invites nominations for officer and ordinary member vacancies for Central Council, and the four Provincial Councils, as well as Member Representatives on the Board of Directors.

The relevant vacancies are identified in the approved 2026 Vacancy Schedule.

For administrative and efficiency purposes the elections listed above will be centrally administered with oversight from the Provincial Councils and the IABA's Auditor.

Boxing Ireland also invites motions from affiliated clubs, or groups of affiliated clubs, for consideration at the Annual General Meeting & Boxing Convention on Saturday, 3 October 2026.

Nominations

- Only a complete nomination pack received by the deadline will be considered.
- The notice of vacancies and the candidate guide identify the form pack required for each office.
- Candidates must not publicly comment, including on social media, on their nomination or another candidate's nomination until the valid candidate list is published by the Nominations Committee or Election Administrator.
- The Nominations Committee will assess eligibility. An applicant may appeal only on a ground permitted by the Election Policy and within the stated appeal window.

Voting

- The centrally administered 2026 election will use postal voting. Electronic voting will not be used for this cycle.
- Nexus is scheduled to post ballot packs on Wednesday, 16 September 2026.
- Ballot papers must be received by midnight on Tuesday, 29 September 2026. Late ballots will not be counted.
- Each eligible club has one vote in the relevant electorate. Detailed voter verification and postal instructions will accompany the formal AGM notice and ballot pack.
- A club that has not received its pack, or believes its pack is incorrect, should contact the Election Administrator immediately and must not submit a duplicate vote.

Club Motions

Motions open on Wednesday, August 26th August 2026. Motions may be submitted only by an affiliated club or group of affiliated clubs, using the Club Motion Submission Form in this pack.

Motions must be submitted to info@boxingireland.ie before 5pm on Friday, 18 September 2026.

Elections Policy Executive Summary

- Elections for the Board of Directors, Central Council, and Provincial Councils will be administered centrally, overseen by the auditors and associated provincial unit.
- Nominations are open until 5pm Tuesday September 8th.
- Votes will be conducted by postal ballot.
- Results will be announced at the AGM and Boxing Convention on Saturday October 3rd.
- As per the current 2019 Rule Book, officers of County Boards and Provincial Units may serve a maximum three terms of 2-years, before stepping down for a mandatory 2-year break in service. This break in service may be deferred by 2-years if no alternative or eligible candidate for that post is nominated.
- In the instance where only one candidate is nominated for an officer position, the candidate must still receive a majority of the votes cast in their favour to be elected.
- County Boards will continue to manage their own election process, with County Boards holding their annual convention before the end of September 2026.
- All elections shall be conducted by secret ballot.
