



Boxing Ireland Taylor Vs Pili Raffle – Terms & Conditions

The Prize: Family ticket for two adults and two children to attend Katie Taylor's final fight at Croke Park on 5 September. Three Family Tickets are available to be won as individual prizes.

1. Eligibility

1. The raffle is open to entrants are **18 years of age or over** at the time of entry.
2. Employees, officers and representatives of Boxing Ireland, and anyone directly involved in organising or administering the raffle, may be excluded from entering.
3. Entrants may be required to provide proof of age and/or eligibility before receiving the prize.

2. Entry

1. Each raffle ticket costs **€10**.
2. Each €10 payment constitutes **one entry** into the raffle, unless otherwise stated by Boxing Ireland.
3. Entries must be received before the closing time of **5pm on September 4th**.
4. Any entries received after the closing time will not be eligible and will not be included in the draw.
5. Boxing Ireland accepts no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, incomplete or otherwise not successfully received.

3. The Prize

1. Three winners will receive one **family ticket for two adults and two children each, for a total of three individual prizes** to attend Katie Taylor's final fight at Croke Park on **5 September**.
2. The prize is subject to the terms, conditions and admission requirements of the event venue and/or event promoter.
3. The prize does not include travel, accommodation, food, drinks, parking or any other expenses unless expressly stated.
4. The prize is **non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or an alternative prize**.
5. In the event that the advertised event is cancelled, postponed, rescheduled or materially changed, Boxing Ireland will not be responsible for any resulting costs or losses. Any replacement or alternative prize will be at the discretion of Boxing Ireland, subject to availability.

4. The Draw

3. Boxing Ireland reserves the right to disqualify any entry where it reasonably believes that the entrant has breached these Terms & Conditions or attempted to manipulate or unfairly influence the raffle.
